WHEREAS the property located at Pt. SE 36-8-7E, Lot 2 Plan 47827, Roll #138408.000, Civic address of 47016 Road 42E, in the RM of Ste. Anne has been issued a Municipal Order in contravention of Building By-Law #09-2017;

AND WHEREAS the registered owner of the property has been issued all the warnings, orders and other documents required under *The Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the registered owner did not comply with the provisions of the order within the time specified in the order, however an appeal, dated December 8, 2020, has been initiated during the allowable time as provided in *The Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 244 of *The Municipal Act*, Council had scheduled a hearing with Resolution #2020-541 to hear the property owner's appeal and review the order on January 27, 2021 at 2 pm, after which Administration was informed that the appellant would be unable to attend at this date and time due to other previously scheduled matters;

BE IT RESOLVED that the CAO make arrangements with the property owner to re-schedule this hearing and if these arrangements cannot be agreed to by January 15, 2021, the CAO shall re-schedule the hearing and give notice to the property owner;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the property owner fail to attend the scheduled hearing, Council shall review the order and make a decision on the matter in accordance with Section 244 of *The Municipal Act*.
