PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING CONDITIONAL USE APPLICATION NO. 02-2006

The minutes of a public hearing to Conditional Use Application No. 02-2006 made by Richard Pelletier on behalf of Premier Horticulture to allow an 'Agro Commercial service including processing & storage' on Part SE 20-8-8E zoned 'AG' Agricultural General.

Owner: Lawrence & Ann Anderson

Applicants: Pichard Pelletier on behalf of Premier Horticulture

<u>Subject:</u> To allow an 'Agro Commercial service including processing & storage' for peat moss products on Part SE 20-8-8E zoned 'AG' Agricultural General.

Location: Part SE 20-8-8E

Reeve Art Bergmann called the public hearing to order at 8:00 PM with the following members of council in attendance: Councillors Courcelles, Saindon, Proulx, Massicotte and Evans. Also in attendance was the Chief Administrative Officer, Alice De Baets.

The applicant, Richard Pelletier on behalf of Premier Horticulture and, Lawrence Anderson, present owner of the property, were in attendance. Richard Pelletier gave a brief outline of the proposed site plan and operation.

Lee Guetre attended in support of the proposed operation which employs many people. If the application is not approved where would the jobs go? What kind of monthly income would be lost?

Roland Chaput asked the applicant what will happen to the old site and will they still be harvesting peat at the old location? Richard informed him that the old site will be cleaned up. They will be harvesting peat at the old location for another 2 to 3 years. When they are finished harvesting peat the site will then be restored.

Both Rolly Larocque and Harry Harder were in favour of the application stating that the operation would be good for the economy and growth of the LUD of Richer.

Raymond Turenne had concerns about the increase in traffic and the safety of his campers who sometimes walk to Richer. Richard indicated that summer is not their busiest time and on long weekends, they quit early because of the increased traffic on the highways. Mr. Turenne enquired whether the municipality had given any consideration to lowering the speed limit on the first mile of PR 302 north of PTH No. 1. Reeve Bergmann reminded him that this is a Provincial Road and not under municipal jurisdiction.

Yvette Wery and Louis Toupin who both live across the road from the proposed operation voiced their concerns about peat dust from the processing plant and road dust from the transport trucks.

Richard Pelletier introduced Paul Davis who has been the Health & Safety Officer for Premier Horticulture for many years. He stated that the health and safety of Premier's employees are his responsibility and the plant has an excellent record.

Reeve Bergmann asked if anyone else wished to speak to the application. No one else came forward.

The hearing was closed and council reconvened to regular session. (Conditional Use No. 02-2006 approved by resolution #154-06)

Chief Administrative Officer
