Infrastructure Grant

41-09 Courcelles - Massicotte

WHEREAS most areas and developments in the R.M. of Ste Anne are served by septic fields or holding tanks, with septage hauled to the municipal lagoon;

AND WHEREAS the existing municipal lagoon does not have adequate storage capacity to meet the growing needs of the population;

AND WHEREAS the R.M. is seeking a proactive method to address emerging concerns with septic fields;

AND WHEREAS the R.M. recognizes Manitoba Conservation's preference to have a regionalized wastewater infrastructure systems;

AND WHEREAS the R.M. of Ste Anne – Regional Wastewater Treatment Lagoon Expansion and Forcemain and Richer Sewer Collection System Project ("the Project") provides a regional sewage collection and treatment system for existing residents in and between the Town of Ste Anne and the L.U.D. of Richer;

AND WHEREAS the Project also provides a piped pressure sewage collection system within the LUD of Richer, eliminating the need for septic fields in this area;

AND WHEREAS the Project will not likely proceed without funding assistance;

BE IT RESOLVED that the R.M. of Ste Anne apply for funding assistance for the Project from the Canada-Manitoba Infrastructure Program with a Municipal Priority Level of 1, or highest priority.
