Committee Reports:

Chairman of the Transportation Committee gave council an update on the following:

- -Dawson Road Project: Work with En-One is done. Weather permitting; a seal coating may be applied yet, this year. No Dust Control can be used on the exposed EN-one product.
- Part Mun Rd 42N has been built up, with material/gravel used from Mun Pit 40E.
- -Ditch mowing for bulrushes has been done in one ditch and worked very well. Consider doing a similar job on Cohoe Road in 2011.
- Councillor Laurie Evans requested that the discussion with Mr. NolanVermette of River Lot 61, Plan 3626 (Lot 1, Plan 19694) who attended the meeting, be recorded in the minutes of the meeting and are as follows:

"Increased flooding has been occurring on his residential lot over the year because of drainage done along #207 and #210, rerouting drainage into the Seine River. There are concerns that the Town of Ste. Anne's (TSA) development at the corner of #207 and #210 will increase the flooding problem, as a culvert will be installed under #207. Council agrees that Water Stewardship and TSA Public works foreman should be made aware of this and that something has to be done to resolve the problem."

Chairman of the Protective Services Committee gave council an update on the following:

-The foundation work has started on the Addition to the Richer Fire Hall.

Chairman of the Personnel and Policy Committee gave council an update "In Camera".

DELEGATION

7:45 p.m. J.P Lanouette made a presentation regarding his proposed subdivision in Pt E ½ 13-8-7E. Council was presented with another draft design of the proposed 3-phase subdivision by the applicant. The suggestion was made that the subdivision be split into 3 separate subdivisions, and when council conditions have been met on the 1st phase, the next phase could be applied for. Council indicated that a decision would be forthcoming at a later date.

9:00 p.m. Bruce Dodds, representing the Hudson Bay Route Association made a presentation promoting the operation of the Churchill, MB Rail line and Port. An annual membership to the Association was proposed to support the cause. Council indicated that the request would be considered at the time of the 2011 budget process.
