- b) Site width from 300 feet to approx. 200 feet for Proposed Lot 1; and
- c) Front yard setback from 125 feet to approx. 4.72 feet for the single-family dwelling, approx. 15.65 feet for the barn and approx. 84.32 feet for the garage on the Residual Lot.
