WHEREAS the Municipality is proposing to complete the following drainage projects on existing drains in 2017 and 2018:

- a. Clean out the north drain along Rd. 43N for approx. 200 feet west of PR302;
- b. Return the north and south drains along Rd. 44N for approx. 2 miles west of Rd. 40E to their originally licensed state;
- c. Clean out the east drain along Rd. 45E for approx. 300 feet south of Rd. 40N;
- d. Clean out the east and west drains along Rd. 40E south of Rd. 40N;
- e. Return the following to their originally licensed states:
 - i. East drain along Rd. 37E for approx. ¾ mile north of Rd. 36N;
 - ii. West drain along Rd. 37E for approx. 1/4 mile south of Rd. 37N; and
 - iii. North drain along Rd. 37N for approx. 3/4 mile west of Rd. 37E;

- f. Clean out the east drain along Rd. 38E for approx. 3/4 mile south of Rd. 47N and the south drain along Rd. 47N for approx. 1 mile west of Rd. 38E;
- g. Clean out the west drain along Rd. 32E for approx. 3/4 mile south of Rd. 44N;
- h. Clean out the east drain along Rd. 31E for approx. 1/2 mile south of the Youville Drain;
- i. Clean out the east drain along Rd. 30E for approx. 1/2 mile south of Rd. 47N;
- j. Brush cut the north drain along Rd. 46N for approx. 1/2 mile east of Rd. 39E; and
- k. Clean out the east drain along Rd. 30E for approx. 1/4 mile south of the Seine River Diversion;
