#### Variation Order #11-19

To allow for the application of *two* garden suites, one to be attached to the existing single-family dwelling and one to be attached to the existing detached garage, by varying the following Sections of amended Zoning By-Law 10-2010, subject to the approval of Conditional Use Order CU#04-19:

- 1. Part II Section 6.3 and Part VI Section 8.0 to allow the two garden suites to be attached whereas garden suite is defined as a separate dwelling unit;
- 2. Part VI Section 8.1 to allow for two garden suites whereas the provisions identify one suite exclusively; and
- 3. Minimum front yard requirement from 125 feet to approx. 70 feet for one of the proposed attached garden suites.
