Conditional Use #12-21 - Aggregate Extraction Operation

At 11:03 am the Reeve called to order the Public Hearing for Conditional Use Order #12-21 to establish an aggregate extraction operation to extract aggregate materials, namely sand and gravel over the course of 2-5 years on SE 10-7-7E, in an area zoned Rural Mixed, reconvening the Hearing adjourned on November 17, 2021.

The Interim Acting CAO read the notice.

The Provincial Technical Review Report was summarized:

- MB Agriculture does not object but notes the possible conditions of approval contained in our Development Plan and expresses that all lands disturbed by aggregate extraction activities should be rehabilitated to a state consistent with surrounding lands;
- MB Infrastructure does not object but notes concerns related to drainage and traffic on PR 210 and requires written confirmation from the developer regarding these concerns;
- MB Historic Resources Branch has no concerns but must be contacted should any heritage resources be encountered when conducting these activities;
- MB Mines Branch has no concerns;
- MB Conservation and Climate, Drainage and Water Rights Licensing Branch expresses that the natural drain found on this section must not be altered unless an approved water control works license has been issues;
- MB Conservation and Climate Water Use has no concerns however if there is any dewatering activity or this operation requires any use of water, the developer must contact them to discuss licensing, permits or possible approvals required;
- BelIMTS has no concerns.

No additional members of the public made presentations in favor or in objection to the proposal.

The applicant did not have any additional comments in response to the Provincial Technical Review Report.

 - g. deadlines for the rehabilitation after active work ceases,
 - h. hours of operation, and
 - i. protection of the natural watercourse that lies to the West of the proposed extraction site;
- 2. That the aggregate fees be paid in accordance with the Municipality's Aggregate Fees By-Law;
- 3. That the applicant provide copies to the Municipality of the correspondence with Manitoba Infrastructure regarding satisfactory completion of Manitoba Infrastructure's requirements;
- 4. That the applicant provide copies to the Municipality of correspondence with the Historic Resources Branch, if applicable;
- 5. That the applicant provide copies to the Municipality of the licenses/permits, if dewatering activities or any use of water results in the requirements of licensing or permits under the Water Rights Act;
