NG 911 Service Agreement

WHEREAS the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) has mandated the transition from the existing Enhanced 911 (E911) service to Next Generation 911 (NG911) services, with implementation scheduled for March 2027;
AND WHEREAS Bell MTS has provided a NG911 Authority Service Agreement to municipalities as part of the provincial transition to NG911 services;
AND WHEREAS the AMM has been actively advocating on behalf of municipalities and has advised that execution of the NG911 Authority Service Agreement prior to September 2026 is recommended to avoid the potential loss of 911 service and the possible requirement to revert to 10-digit emergency telephone dialing;
AND WHEREAS Council has reviewed the NG911 Authority Service Agreement and recognizes the importance of ensuring continued access to emergency 911 services for residents of the Municipality;
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council approves entering into the NG911 Authority Service Agreement with Bell MTS;
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Reeve and CAO are authorized to sign the NG911 Authority Service Agreement and any related documents necessary to facilitate the Municipality's participation in the NG911 service transition.
