By-Law No. 02-2026, being an amendment to Zoning By-Law No. 13-2023**

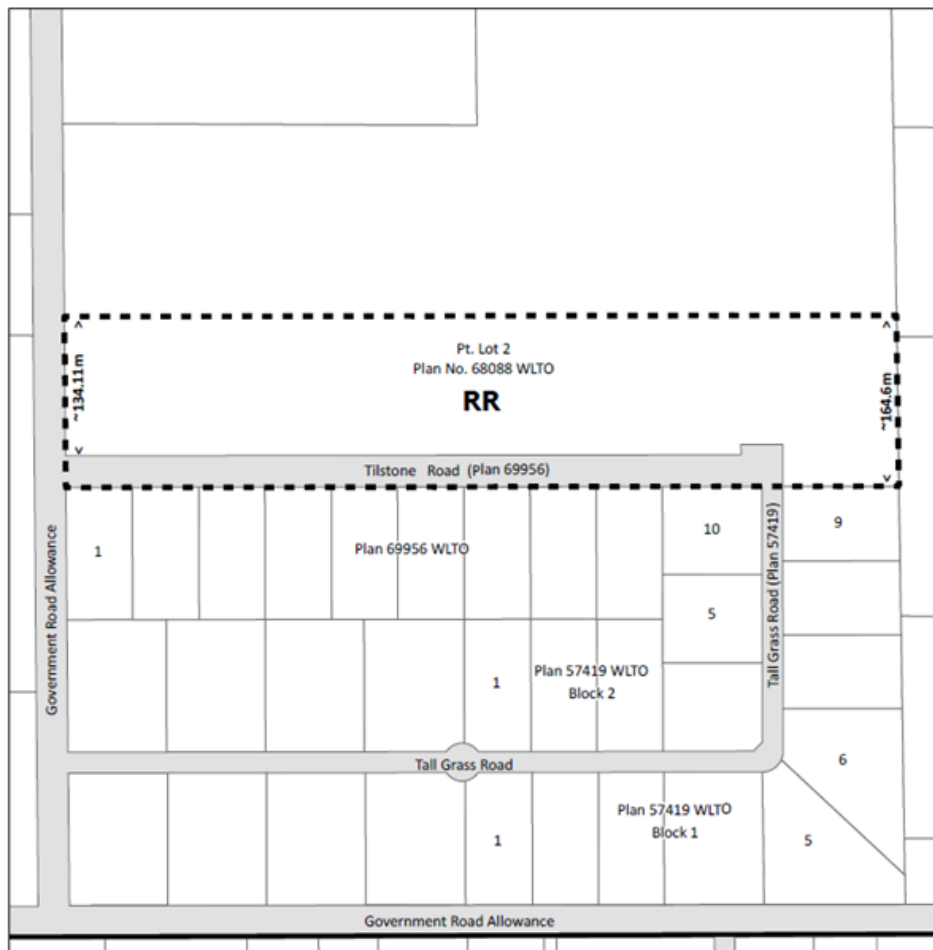
The Rural Municipality of Ste. Anne, under the authority of *The Planning Act*, will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at the Municipal Office Council Chambers at the address shown above on **Wednesday, June 10, 2026**, at **10:00 am** in respect to the following matter:

General Intent:

1. To re-designate the land generally described as Pt. of W1/2-5-7-7-E Being Pt. Lot 2, Plan 68088 WLTO, as shown on the map below, from Agricultural Mixed-Use Areas to Rural Residential Area.

2. To rezone the land generally described as Pt. of W1/2-5-7-7-E Being Pt. Lot 2, Plan 68088 WLTO, as shown on the map below, from Agricultural Mixed-Use Zone to Rural Residential Zone.
