 - 5. Addition of Policy 5.4.2.9 which states that lots in certain rural residential areas have a minimum site area requirement of 3.5 acres.

 - 7. Policy 5.1.2.3 be further amended to read that no commercial and industrial shall occur within 2 miles of the City of Steinbach (as per request from the City of Steinbach).
