Emergency Prevention Order

BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 8.2 (1) of *The Emergency Measures Act*, Chapter E.80 of the Continuing Consolidation of the Statutes of Manitoba, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Ste. Anne pass an Emergency Prevention Order to mitigate <u>overland flooding</u> in the Rural Municipality of Ste. Anne by any actions required;

FURTHERMORE BE IT RESOLVED that this order be effective from the 30th day of March, 2009 to the 22nd day of April, 2009.
