- Municipal Roads built 50 years ago cannot support the size and weight of trucks of today. He stressed the importance of "No Truck Route" roads to prevent damage to the road bed.
- Municipal grading is still not recommended at this time due to grader causing more damage on soft roads;
- E-n-1 product used on Dawson Road Project in 2010 is holding up well. There are some spots that need to be looked after. Seal-coating does have a warranty.
- Beaver are causing road damage in the eastern part of RM, but unable to determine where the dams are at this time.
