- 7. That the Municipality will not take ownership of the driveway in the future;
- 8. That it will be the future land owner's responsibility to negotiate and receive permission to access and use the neighbouring owners existing trail, if any crossover onto the property results due to the existing trail being used in the building of this proposed driveway.
