AND WHEREAS the RM of Ste. Anne received a grant of \$1,000,000 from the Manitoba Safe Restart Program administered through the Manitoba Water Services Board, with the balance of the total project cost to be funded by the RM of Ste. Anne;

AND WHEREAS \$757,400 of the total Municipal project costs have already been funded from the Municipal Waste Management Reserve Fund;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, rather than the debenture authorized under borrowing By-law #01-2021, the 2021 expenses incurred for this lagoon expansion project be funded from the At Large portion of the Municipal Gas Tax Reserve Fund;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT provisions for the completion of this project be included in the 2022 Budget from municipal reserve funds.

- 5. That the subdivision administrative fee of \$375 be required in accordance with By-Law 07-2011
- 6. That a lot levy of \$1,500.00 per parcel created be required; and
- 7. That all costs including any legal and engineering costs incurred due to this subdivision be borne by the applicant.

BE IT RESOLVED that the request to have the Municipality extend Road 38N be denied;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RM would be willing to consider entering into an agreement for 100% privately funded road development to municipal standards.
